### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Meet with the Creative Director and Post-Production Director to determine production vision
- Review raw material to determine edit structure & selects categories
- Pull the usable sections of clips into selects categories for assembly
- Edit together the rough assembly of each project using the script, planned edit structure, selects categories, and pancake timeline
- Insert necessary voiceover, stock footage, sound effects, music, graphics, and visual effects
- Ensure the project follows a logical sequence and the creative vision

- Consult with the Creative Director, Post-Production Director and Producer throughout the project
- Apply feedback to the edit(s) from Frame.io or in-person review sessions
- On-set roles include PA, DAM, DIT, Video Village Tech, and Script Supervisor
